
Shorelines Publication

The Council has decided to engage in an every other week Shorelines publication as a pilot for three months. We are finding there seems to be repetition and Christine could certainly use the extra time to apply to her Community Wellness Coordinator role. We will be seeking your feedback late May on whether this is sustainable. Stay Tuned.

Our Church Council, after conferring with our By-law officer and OPP, has made the decision to be more rigorous in protecting our private parking places along the Queens Ave side of our building. Sadly, we will be giving up revenue that supports community needs. However, increasingly there is a need to ensure that our staff and members of our COF using our building are able to find parking. With the recent opening of Crabby Joe's, parking concerns have dramatically increased despite it still being winter. As a result, our signage will be effective all year round rather than just May 15- to September 15.

All members of our community of faith and our staff will receive laminated parking passes. We recommend that you should set one on your dash or visor when you are attending a church event. In the very near future we will be installing signage that makes it clear it is private parking and owners of cars may receive either fines and or their car may be towed.







