

There is still time to make an Anniversary offering!



Meditation: "Cast all your anxiety on the Lord because God cares for you."

- 1 Peter 5:7

In the middle of a storm of anxious thoughts, feeling alone, lost, and hopeless is easy. Worry steals the joy from us and creates stress. We all experience it.

But the truth is, we are never alone. We believe that the presence of God is with us at all times, whether we feel that presence or not.

1 Peter 5:7 calls us to surrender our anxieties, worries, and fears to God as we pray.

And to remember that we don't need to deal with our struggles alone. God is

willing and able to carry them with us.

And we need to stop worrying so much about tomorrow because it's out of our control. (I know...easier said than done!) But we're not alone in these struggles. Many people grapple with feelings of restlessness, worry, and fear. There is solace in the shared experience, knowing others have walked this path.

And in believing that the Holy Spirit is with us at all times - even when we are anxious or feel stressed.

The journey is challenging, but by trusting in God, I believe we can find stillness...peace. At our requests, God helps us calm our fears and anxiety with the assurance of presence, strength and love.

And that starts with us making a decision to surrender our anxieties, and trust that God truly cares everything that is concerning us. And to also believe that the Holy Spirit is fighting for us; we don't need to be afraid.


