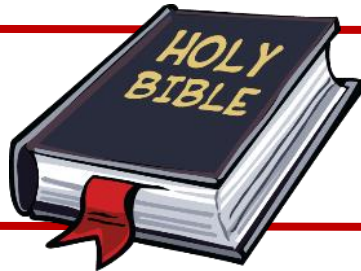

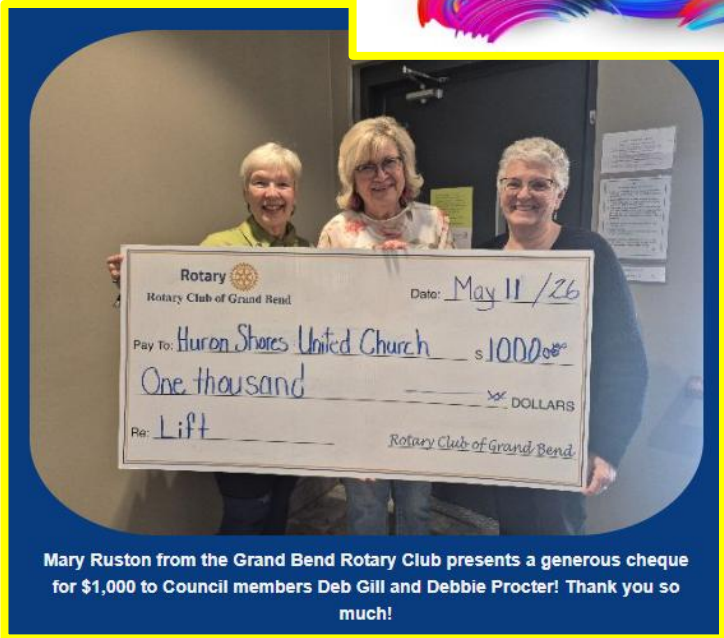

Latest income Totals – Operations offerings increased from \$27,481 Mar 31/25 to \$27,882 Mar 31/26 to \$43,460.34 May 17/26. Mortgage debt retirement offerings increased from \$4,633 Mar 31/25 to \$5,923 Mar 31/26 to \$8,122 May 17/26. We are going in the right direction, but we need to continue this trend.

The “Audacious Dreamers” Donor Recognition Display will be wound up as of June 30. A permanent display will be mounted on the wall between the offices in one larger frame, donors will continue to be shown in their giving categories, but no dollar amounts will be shown.

All donors will be notified of this change via email.

Legacy Giving – The team is researching the option of leaving bequests to HSUC through your estate; more information will follow.

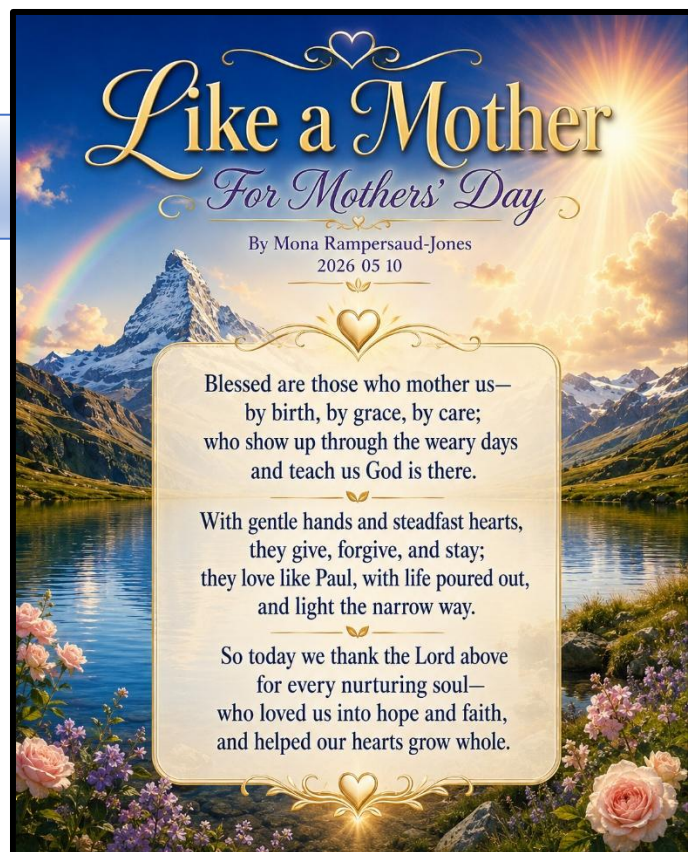
