

Meditation: What would you do if you were God?

I mean, let's admit it: Deep down, there are times when we want to be.

There are times when we act like we are.

There are times when I want to "set the world straight" – when I'd love to have things turn out exactly the way I want them to go. And when they didn't go that way, well, it wouldn't be pretty.





So let's imagine for a minute that you are God. Imagine that you are omnipotent. That you have all power over the space-time continuum, and that you can speak anything you want into existence.

Anything you desire is at your disposal. What would you do? What would you create? What would the world be like?

It's fun to think about.

Here are some basic ideas I came up with:

I would have a pool...always kept at a warmer temperature, but refreshing. (*I mean, this summer doesn't everyone want this?*) And so I might as well make the outside temperature always perfect...around 20 or so. With occasional thunderstorm for interest and excitement!
